Guidelines for Use of Lodge and Facilities 325 Sycamore Ln Rutherfordton, NC 28139

Welcome and Blessings in the Name of the Lord!

- 1. You are welcome to move tables and furniture as needed, but please return all furniture to its original location.
- 2. We have place settings for about 30 people stocked in the kitchen. We strongly encourage the usage of these reusable items so we can all cut down on the materials going in to our landfills. Use them and run the dishwasher if possible.
- **3.** Thermostat controls are located on the main floor to the right of the utility room door on the wall, and upstairs in the hallway beside bathroom door. Very rarely do you need the upstairs heat on as heat rises up the stairs and warms the rooms nicely. Please leave the upstairs heat off unless it is very cold. When leaving, turn heat down to 60* and A/C to 75*.
- 4. When you leave please strip beds that <u>have been used</u> and place sheets, pillowcases and towels in tubs on each level. Do not remove blankets unless they are soiled. Vacuum and brooms are stored in the utility room and cleaning supplies should be located in all bathrooms if you need them during your stay.
- **5.** Ice machine is located in the utility room. Please turn off when leaving. Switch is located to the left of ice machine on the wall.
- **6.** You may use the fireplace if it is closely attended and NEVER left unattended. Please make sure damper is OPEN. You may want to bring a fire log for starting purposes. Firewood is located on the porch or under the Lodge.
- **7.** When outside, there are to be no activities of a deleterious nature i.e. foghorns, noisemakers, fireworks, fog or smoke machines, or loud concert-type music.
- **8.** Please take all leftover food with you or make arrangements with staff.
- **9.** For trash disposal, ask staff for location of dumpster.

CHECK LIST FOR LEAVING AND CONTACT NUMBERS

- 1. Thermostats are turned down or off.
 - 2. Ice Machine turned off.
 - 3. Dryer is not running.
- 4. Take trash or make other arrangements with staff.
 - 5. Do not lock doors. Ministry staff will take care of lockup.
- 6. SAY A PRAYER OF BLESSING FOR THE NEXT GROUP AND ALL ONGOING MINISTRY!
